

# Easy Cinnamon Roll MIX



Stir all ingredients together and store in an airtight container. Give with a copy of these directions:

- 18-1/4 oz. box yellow cake mix
- 5 c. all-purpose flour
- 2 T. instant yeast

## Easy Cinnamon Rolls ...to make, bake & eat.

Combine mix with 2-1/2 cups hot water. Stir well and let rise in a warm place until double in size. Punch down dough, roll in a 15" x 10" rectangle. Spread dough with 1/4 cup melted butter, then sprinkle 2 tablespoons cinnamon and 3/4 cup sugar evenly over top. Roll dough jelly roll-style ~ slice in 18 equal size rolls.

Divide rolls between 2 greased 13" x 9" baking dishes and let rise again until double. Bake at 350 degrees for 25 to 30 minutes or until golden.
