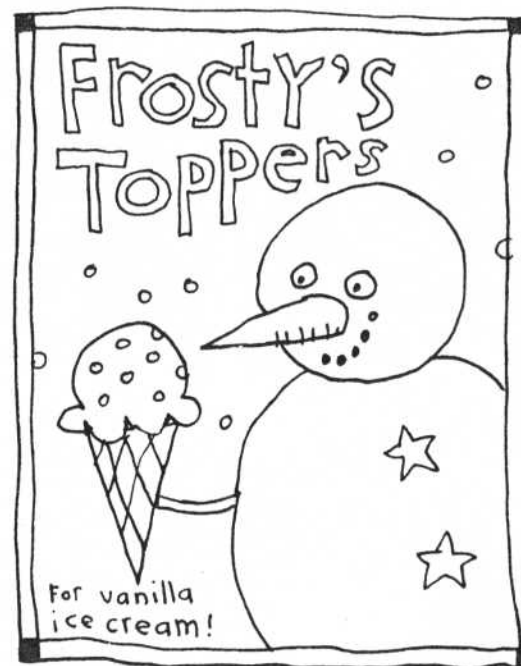


Reindeer need their veggies, too, you know!

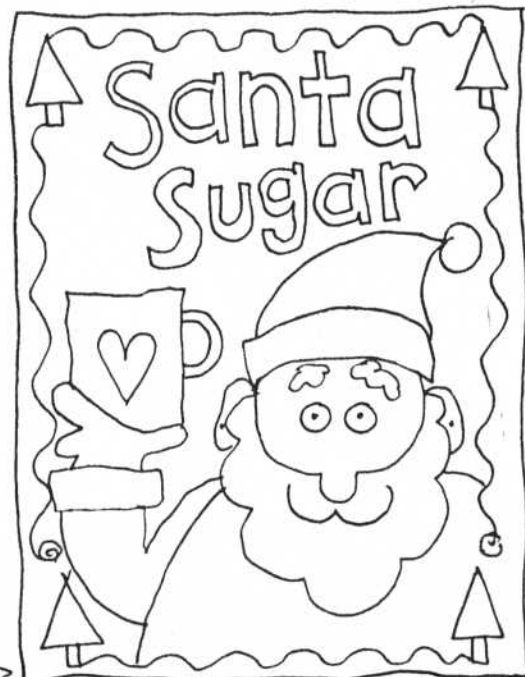
