

# Incredible Cobbler Mix

a recipe from Samantha Starks  
Madison, WI

- 1 t. baking powder    1 t. vanilla powder  
1 c. sugar                1 c. all-purpose flour



Mix together all ingredients until well blended. Store in airtight container. Give with the following recipe:

## Incredible Cobbler (So good!)

- 4 c. berries            1 c. butter, melted  
1/4 c. orange juice    1 egg  
1/4 c. sugar            cobbler mix  
1 t. cinnamon

Blend together berries, orange juice, sugar & cinnamon; pour into a 13"x9" baking pan. Combine butter & egg, add dry cobbler mix and stir well. Drop cobbler mixture by spoonfuls over berries in baking pan. Bake at 375 degrees for 30 to 40 minutes or 'til golden.

## Fruit Painting with Mary Elizabeth

You can paint CHERRIES! Make a red circle of paint; now add a white dot of paint slightly off-center on that red circle - that's the reflection of light. Add a green curvy line for a stem, and you're done!



You can paint BLUEBERRIES the same way - just skip the stem and use blue & white paint.

RASPBERRIES are easy - just dip your pinky in red paint and dab some little dots in a triangle shape!
