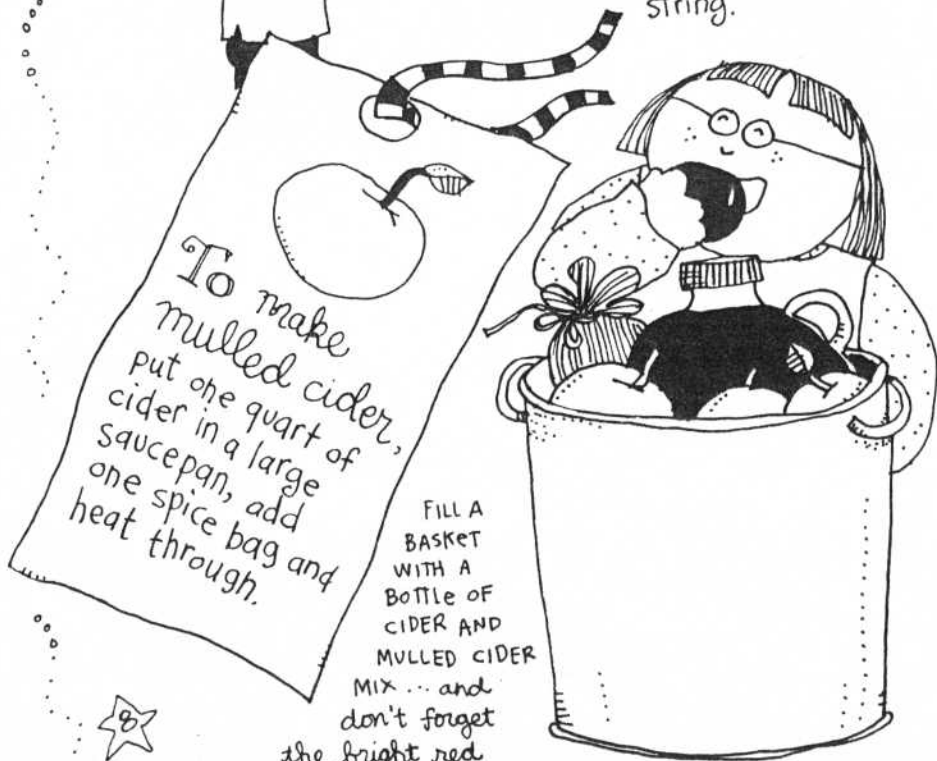


Mulled Cider Mix

a recipe from April Jacobs
Loveland, CO

1 1/3 c. one-inch cinnamon sticks
1 1/3 c. whole cloves
1 1/3 c. whole allspice

Blend spices together and spoon
1 to 2 tablespoons in a 4-inch
square of cheesecloth. Bring
corners of cheesecloth together
and secure with cotton
string.



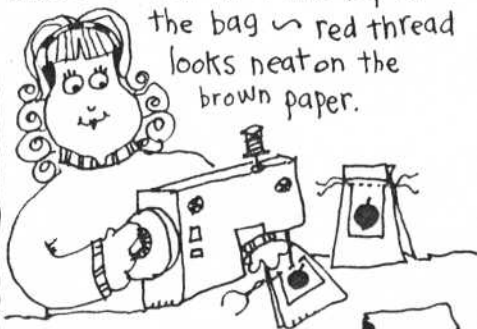
To make

Package
Mulled Cider Mix
in a memorable

way: Remember those little
brown paper bags that penny
candy used to come in? Scout
around your local merchants
and find a source for them
(lunch-size bags also work but
the little ones fit better). Just
drop the mix packet inside the
bag and then position a copy
of the mix instructions on the
outside of the bag near the top
(see illustration above). Now just
run the bag through your
sewing machine and stitch it
shut, running the stitch right
over the card! You can leave
the thread ends long or trim
them off! Holly likes to stitch
about one inch from the top of
the bag ~ red thread
looks neat on the
brown paper.



Tear a
raggedy
strip of
red
plaid
homespun
and sew
the ends
to
your
paper bag as shown
for a fun little tote to
hide yummy stuff in ...
like Mulled Cider Mix!
