1/2 c. QUICK-COOKING OATS,
UNCOOKED
1/2 c. RASPBERRY CHIPS
1 c. BROWN SUGAR, PACKED
& DIVIDED

2 c. BUTTERMILK BISCUIT BAKING MIX,
DIVIDED

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In a wide-mouth, one-quart glass jar, layer ingredients in this order: OATS, RASPBERRY CHIPS, 1/2 CUP BROWN SUGAR, ONE CUP BUTTERMILK BISCUIT BAKING MIX, 1/2 CUP BROWN SUGAR AND ONE CUP BUTTERMILK BISCUIT BAKING MIX. Pack layers in jar tightly, and if there's room left, add more chips to top of jar. Give with these instructions:

Combine jar mix with 1/2 cup melted butter, one egg and one teaspoon vanilla extract; blend well. Press cookie mix in a greased 8" baking dish ~ bake at 350 degrees for 18 to 22 minutes or until golden and almost set. Makes 16 bars ~ enough for you and your little elves!

1/2 c. peanut butter chips
1/2 c. chopped pecans
1 c. brown sugar, packed
and divided

2 c. biscuit baking
mix, divided

Layer ingredients in a wide-mouth, one-quart canning jar in the following order: PEANUT BUTTER CHIPS, PECANS, 1/2 CUP BROWN SUGAR, 1 CUP BISCUIT BAKING MIX, 1/2 CUP BROWN SUGAR, 1 CUP BISCUIT BAKING MIX. Pack tightly between each layer. Additional peanut butter chips can be added if there is extra room when you reach the top of the canning jar. Attach a gift card that reads:

Empty jar in a large mixing bowl. Add 1/2 cup melted butter, one egg and one teaspoon vanilla extract. Stir to blend, then press into an 8" greased baking dish. Bake at 350 degrees for 18 to 20 minutes or til golden. Makes 18 bars. Enjoy with a big glass of cold milk!
